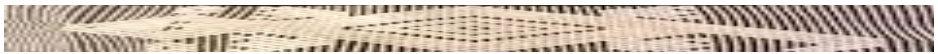

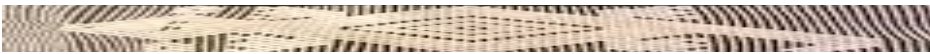

Exports are goods comprising at least 50 percent Timor-Leste content by value.

Re-Exports are goods for export that were previously imported into Timor-Leste and comprise less than 50 percent Timor-Leste content by value. The external trade register cannot be compared directly with national accounts figures, because the aggregation and Classification, given its own purposes, they are not exactly the same.
